Dropped tools and accidental contact with electrical systems are common causes of arc flash injuries. Prevent accidents: mark your workplace with elecDirect.com® Arc Flash Labels to inform those working in potentially hazardous situations. The Bureau of Labor Statistics states that electrical burns, explosions and electrocution/ electrical shock resulted in over 11,000 days away from work in 1994.
